This movement exploration class incorporates the wide span of physical coordination that your young dancer is developing. Creatro is a creative zone for students to improve their acting abilities, social skills and overall confidence using English. The students will create their own original Stage-Play! From narrative theory to scriptwriting; from scene blocking to the live final production. We take acting seriously, so we will focus on body language, facial expression, tone of voice, and the art of bringing a character to life on stage. And of course, we will have a lot of fun along the way!

Throughout the course, students will use and improve the 4 key language-learning skills: Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening.

In the first term we will play drama and theatre games, work on group dynamics and learn a variety of acting skills and techniques for the play. In second term we will focus more on Narrative Theory and the different aspects of writing a script. We will discuss and create the story, the problem, the characters, the setting, the genre and the moral message. It's time to bring your creativity!

In third term the students will receive their characters and a copy of the finished script they have created. We will spend time producing the stage-play, transforming it from a written script to a theatre performance.

The course is run by Phil, a native English teacher with 10 years of experience teaching English and Theatre in schools in Madrid. Phil was born in Manchester (England) and has been living in Spain since 2014. During his time in Madrid he has directed 13 original stage-plays that were written and created by students.

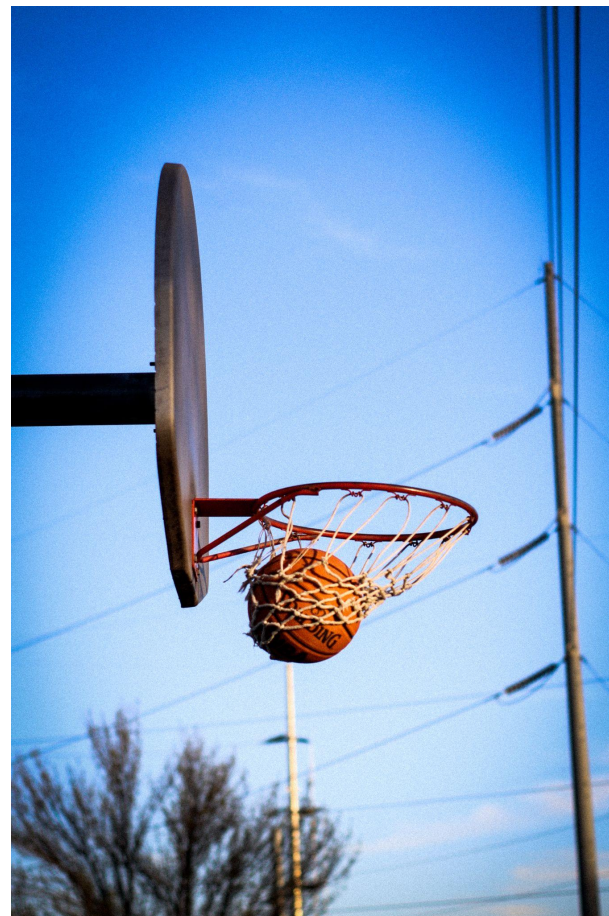

Advanced Dance Exploration & Choreography

Advanced Dance Exploration gives the students the space to acquire new dance skills while advancing their creativity as they mature into a new phase of development. Instead of focusing on only one genre, it will leave freedom to delve with higher specificity into various genres such as ballet, contemporary, jazz, hip-hop, and tap. Depending on the interests of the group, we may focus more on certain genres, but learn about the relation to the others. While learning sequencing, musicality, and dynamics of the genres, their creative sides will continue to be nurtured with a more advanced approach to improvisation and with the addition of exploring composition (choreography). Opposed to simply learning and repeating dances, the class will offer a more whole and integrated experience.

Sewing (Upper Elementary)

Min 6 ch/Max 6ch

In this garment-construction class, children will see the process of creating a piece of clothing. In first term our project will be a pair of shorts with pockets and elasticated waist. In the course of the class we will going through each step of the process from measuring to cutting out the pattern pieces to sewing the shorts together. The children will be measuring, cutting, sewing, and testing while becoming familiar with the parts and techniques of the sewing machine. The class will take place in the staff room at school where we have three sewing machines so the children will be in pairs for their work. This is so they are able to watch, learn from, and help each other. Material, pins, machines, and scissors will be included and provided by the teacher. If children want to bring their own fabric then the specific requirements (type, length) can be communicated, but this is not required.

Children will need a snack with them to have after school.

Extracurricular Enrollment

Please read: Please note that by signing up your child using the Google form or by email, you agree to the following conditions:

ENROLLING/WITHDRAWING: To enroll your child please use the link provided in the accompanying email. *Your child will then be signed up unless you hear from me to let you know the class is full or will not be running due to lack of interest. Make sure you write your child's name otherwise we will not know who it is for and it will be void.*

We will ask families if they want to re-enrol in individual music classes to provide continuity to the children. We will also give priority for children moving through grados in Clave de Si. All other classes will be on first come, first served basis. To enroll in a new class once the school year is started, let Giuliana know before the beginning of the term. If it happens during a term, you will need to pay for the whole term, we do not prorate the costs.

To withdraw your child from a class, parents will need to inform the school and teacher 30 days before the start of the new term. If you inform us after those 30 days, the school will charge the whole term. There is no prorate.

If, during the course of a term children drop from an activity reaching less than the minimum desired, the activity will be cancelled for the following term.

Charge for activities will be debited before the start of the activity. Once you have been charged, we cannot reimburse the fee.

START/END DATES: Classes will start the week of October 1 and will end the week of June 8.

CANCELLATIONS/RE-SCHEDULING AND MAKE-UP CLASSES:

The classes will take place according to Madrid Montessori School calendar (except En Clave de Si classes as the teachers do not operate on public holidays).

If the teacher needs to cancel a class they will find a substitute teacher or will need to reschedule the class giving the families 24hrs notice at least.

If a child misses a group class they won't have an extra one.

If a child is going to miss an individual class, the parents should inform the teacher.

Classes falling on days where the school *is closed* will not be rescheduled.

Classes that fall on days where there is a *school field trip* will not be made up for.

Classes that fall on *not regular school days* (Special person's day, Spring fair, etc.) will take place.

AGE: Children can enroll in the different classes in the term where they turn the age indicated for the class.

FEES: All fees are per term. Term 1: until the Winter Break. Term 2: until the Spring Break. Term 3: until the Summer Break.

COMMUNICATION: All communication regarding extracurricular classes is done between the parents and the specialist teacher except for enrolling and withdrawing.

The teachers will contact parents to arrange any necessary rehearsals. Prior to the start of the extracurricular classes you will have in Phidias the contacts of the extracurricular teachers.
